I.

Councilman Wood made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman Holliman, to suspend the reading and approval of the minutes from the previous Council meeting. All Council members present voted in favor of the motion.

II.

New Business:

Mayor Fogleman advised the purpose of the meeting was to discuss and/or authorize Mayor Fogleman to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement for calendar year 2022. The Sheriff and the Quorum Court want the agreement signed by November 1, 2022.

The agreement stipulates that Marion will pay Crittenden County for dispatch services originating from within the Marion city limits. Marion's part of any annual deficit (shortfall) resulting from operations of the communication center will be equal to Marion's percentage of the total dispatch calls made by the Sheriff's Office Dispatch during calendar year 2022 and for following calendar years. Marion's total cost will be capped at \$100,000.00 per year.

After much discussion, Councilman Wood made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman Holliman, to authorize Mayor Fogleman to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement and the city to receive a report from the county of the monthly call volume. All Council members present voted in favor of the motion.

There being no further business to come before the Council and upon proper motion, the meeting was adjourned at 6:09 p.m.
